Why is this change taking place

 Significant change in regulatory landscape and wider regulatory remit requiring a new approach - Clearer Quicker Tougher (proactive, preventative through deeper relationship with strategically important schemes) and stronger regulatory grip on a larger number of schemes (throwing the net wider, expanding reach).

Supervision – Vision

Clearer, quicker and tougher engagement, proactively addressing key risks to improve member outcomes. Being clear in our expectations and effective in influencing voluntary compliance. Working effectively with Enforcement to transfer situations promptly where voluntary compliance is not achieved. Increasing our regulatory grip, strengthening our regulatory presence and mitigating risk to our statutory objectives

Relationship Department

To have a team that engages proactively with the largest schemes and schemes of importance to build effective relationships focussed on identifying and addressing risks

Event Driven Department

Proactive response to singular risks eg fair treatment of schemes

Rapid Response team for initial engagement on crystallising risks within short timescale Engagement with matters arising from Rapid Response which require deeper response and reactive engagement on most risky reactive DB valuations and clearance

Enforcement – Vision

- Clearer, quicker and tougher enforcement, setting our regulatory tone, increasing our regulatory grip, and acting as a visible deterrence therefore mitigating risk to our objectives
- Prevent, prohibit, remedy and or punish in relation to harm to our statutory objectives

Investigations Department

Specialist investigators including financial investigators to undertake thorough investigations to establish options for regulatory enforcement therefore increasing the speed, focus and robustness of evidence gathering and handling and providing broad view on use of powers

Proceedings Department

Regulators that undertake objective review of enforcement options - driving positive regulatory outcomes increasing the focus, delivery and effectiveness of our regulatory work
